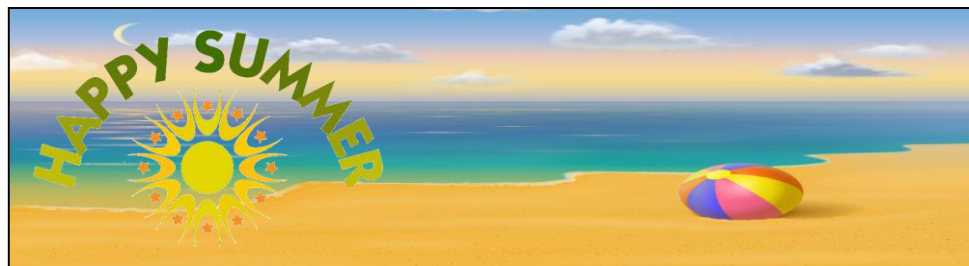

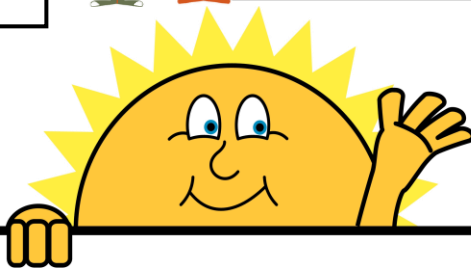
Year 6
