out for sessions later in the autumn.

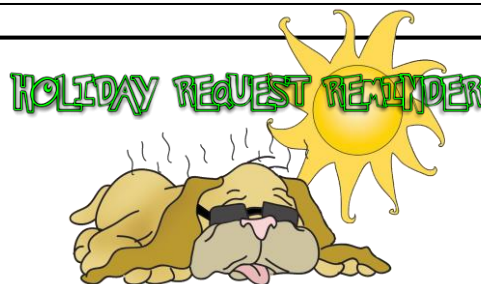
