Reverend Robb will lead our service on Monday and talk about the traditions of Harvest.



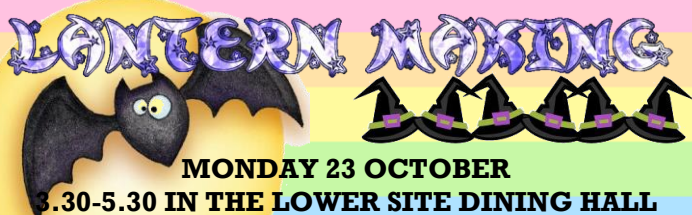
Year 5 Family Lunch
