


We have had a fantastic first week back at Ash Green. It has been wonderful to welcome new children – and staff – and also to catch up with everyone else after a long break! Next week at Ash Green we will be firmly back in the swing of things. Maths sets will commence in KS2 and ICT across school. Parents of Year 2 children are invited to meet the teacher on Monday and Year 1 parents can meet their children's teacher on Tuesday (see below). Year 4 will swim on Monday for the first time. We end the week on Friday with our Celebration assemblies – KS2 at 9.05am – Reception and KS1 at 2.50pm – all welcome.



ATTENDANCE

Attendance at Ash Green is something we are very proud of. This year we will continue our weekly class and individual rewards as well as our termly draws for £50 shopping vouchers from the children with 100% attendance each half term.

As a Local Authority school we have followed Local Authority guidelines in terms of holiday requests. Holidays in term time are unauthorised unless there are exceptional circumstances. As with other LA schools, unauthorised absences under 5 days have not been referred to the Education Welfare Service for fines but longer absences have. Parents have been very understanding and supportive of this but have raised the point- for example- that their child with outstanding attendance was fined for a 5 day absence whereas a child with poor attendance was not fined for a 4 day absence. This year, we have decided that if an absence between 5 and 10 days has been requested and a child has attendance of 96% or above, then this absence will not be referred to the Education Welfare Service for a fine. Thank you for your support.



It has been an incredibly positive start back to school by ALL of our children. Behaviour has been absolutely impeccable and staff have been thrilled with all your children. Sadly, we have already had isolated incidents of parental disputes being played out in, or near, the grounds of school. This simply cannot happen.
