SCHOOL GATEWAY IMPORTANT INFORMAITON

From January 2020 <u>ALL</u> school payments will need to be paid via the School Gateway system. Below are links for you to click on and download the app.

We need to collect an e mail address from <u>ALL</u> the main parental contact number for every child. If you have not already done this please send your e mail address to us using the following e mail address or bring it in to school:

To use this system Parent/Carers have to download the School Gateway app from the App store and register themselves before any payments - dinners, breakfast club, after school club, trips etc - can be booked and paid for from January 2020.

In order to sign into School Gateway the email address and mobile telephone number that you have given to us in school MUST match your log in details.

Well done to our singing club who performed brilliantly at Rev. Robb's Christmas luncheon this week.


A massive bravo to our Christmas Caroller's who sang their hearts out at Morrisons yesterday and today. They raised over £200 – well done children!
