We are pleased to inform you that following the outstanding success of previous courses and the weekly coaching sessions, we are organising the 2022 summer football fun week.

The children will be coached by CRB POLICE CHECKED and F.A. QUALIFIED COACHES who are used to working with and bringing the best out in children.
